"Feasibility of an observatory of non-conventional water resources (NCWR) and associated renewable energies" led by IME

6 December, 2021 – 9:30 -12:30

Background

Authorities in charge of water or energy are faced with complex issues when it comes to planning, implementing and then managing the desalination or reuse of treated wastewater: this mobilizes additional water resources but consumes more energy at a time when climate change requires less consumption.

The World Water Council thought that information sharing and international exchanges within an Observatory could help stakeholders in this field, and launched a feasibility study on the Mediterranean Sahel area. It is a question of providing the elements of decision as to the possible creation and possible content of such an Observatory.

Objectives of the event

Make a significant contribution to the ongoing feasibility study entrusted to the Mediterranean Water Institute, and feed into session 2 of the Forum, dedicated the next day to unconventional water resources and dedicated renewable energies.
