



COUNTRY CHALLENGES

WFD standard and IWRM are clear goals

- Inherited water governance: system and infrastructure
 - Monitoring of hydrology and chemistry
 - Major gaps of data / knowledge
 - Many deteriorated water bodies but also very intact river areas (ref sites)
 - Non-sustainable use
- Countries in political and economic transition
- Loads of external support limits of uptake capacity
- Inconsistent modernising of water policies and management
- Political and bureaucratic risks
- Low budget and own income
- High dynamics in man-power and institutions
- Undermined responsibilities (control, accounting, enforcement)














River Basin Management Plans (RBMPs) already adopted

Other EaP river basins


