4 different options (according to the preferences expressed by the participants and the number of places available):

Option 1:

Semnoz mountain

Chairlift to the top of the mountain plateau. Presentation of the water-related issues on the mountain range. Visit of the new water retention infrastructure. Explanation of the renovation project of the building "le courant d'Ere".

Option 2:

Drinking water production facilities Visit of the La Puya plant, where water is pumped and pre-treated (microstraining). Transfer to the Espagnoux drinking water production plant.

Presentation of the processes of the drinking water production process, for the treatment to the supply.

Option 3:

Fier river valley

Visit of the wastewater sanitation facilities in the Fier river valley: biogas methanation unit of the SILA (Lake Annecy District Authority) & SILOE depollution unit.

Presentation of the re-meandering project of the Viéran river & presentation of the "Forest sport policy" with Annecy city and the National Forests Office (ONF). Focus on remarkable trees used to produce seeds for reforestation.

• Option 4:

Thiou river

Stroll on the Annecy Lake outlet and presentation of its interest as a freshness island to limit the impact of heat. Presentation of the Turbine on the Thiou River.
